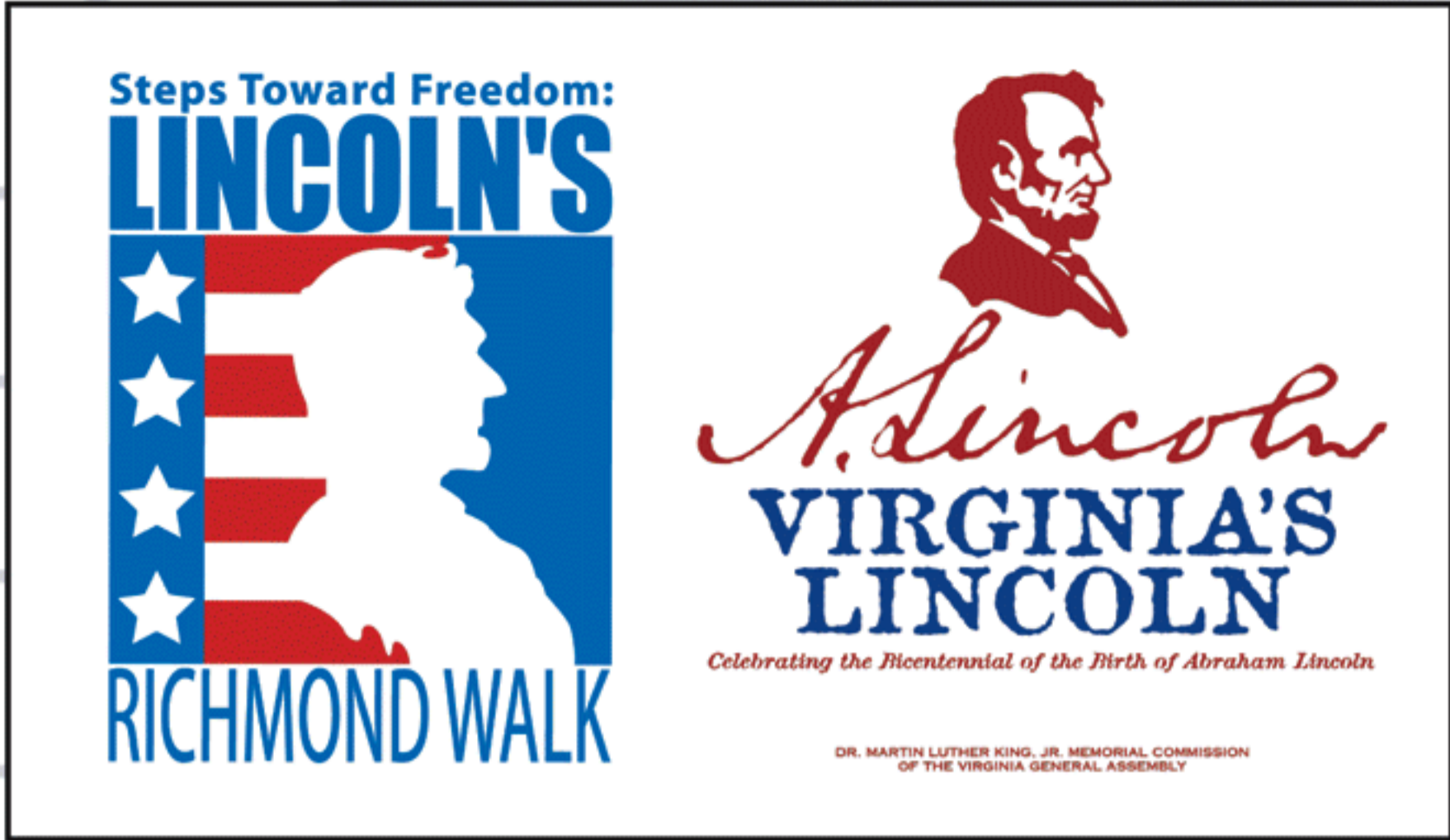


# LINCOLN WALK

## Lincoln Stops #

*Lincoln is documented to have passed through these locations*

- STOP 1:** 17th and Dock Streets  
Near the Floodwall
- STOP 2:** 17th and Main Streets  
Southwest corner
- STOP 3:** 14th and Main Streets  
Southeast corner
- STOP 4:** 14th and Franklin Streets  
West side of Franklin Street
- STOP 5:** 12th and Clay Streets  
Southeast corner of 12th Street, in front of the White House of the Confederacy
- STOP 6:** Capitol Square  
Near Washington Statue
- STOP 7:** Rocketts Landing  
Dock Street, east of Pear Street

## Information Stops i

*Lincoln likely passed through these locations*

- Canal Walk/Dock Street  
Near 17th Street
- Southside of Main Street at 15th Street  
Across from Reconciliation Statue
- Southside of Broad Street at 14th Street  
Across from College Street
- Southside of Broad Street at 11th Street
- Clay and 10th Streets  
In front of The Valentine Richmond History Center
- Capitol Square  
At the base of Capitol's south portico steps
- 10th and Cary Streets  
Southeast corner
- 13th and Cary Streets  
Southeast corner

- 17th and Dock Streets
- Valentine Richmond History Center (Clay and 10th Streets)

## Restrooms

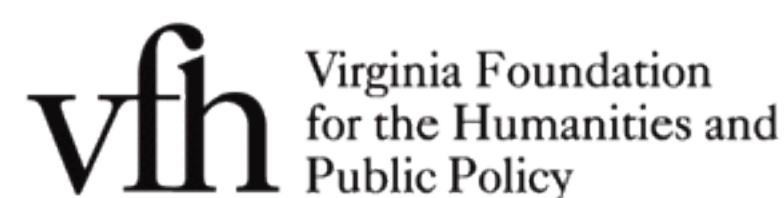
- Valentine Richmond History Center (Clay and 10th Streets)
